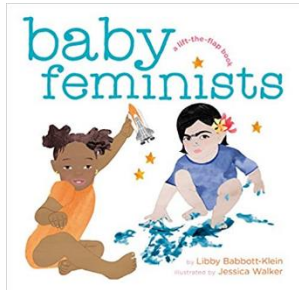

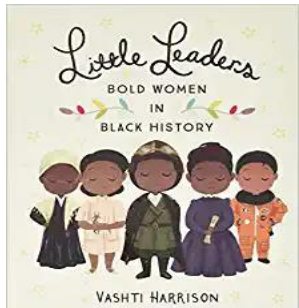


### **BABY FEMINISTS**

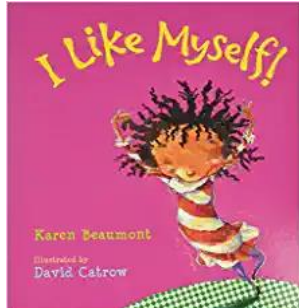


### **LITTLE LEADERS - BOLD WOMEN IN BLACK HISTORY**

This book features forty trailblazing black women in American history, with illustrations that bring to life both iconic and lesser-known female figures of Black history.

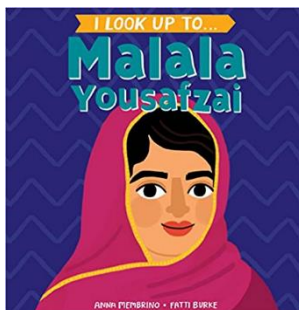


### **I LIKE MYSELF**

This ode to self-esteem encourages girls to appreciate everything about themselves-inside and out. This book has an important message that your self worth and self esteem are something that come from only yourself.

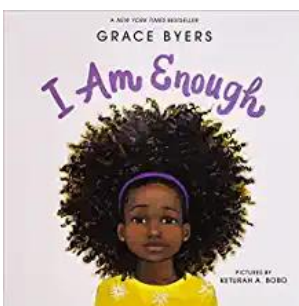


### **I LOOK UP TO MALALA YOUSAFZAI**
