
# BOOK OF THE MONTH:

## 1. Introducing the book:



### **Exploring the Cover**

Do you recognize the character? It is Pete the Cat who is ready for yet another adventure! This time he is going camping. Can you name some of the camping items depicted on the cover?

#### **Building Background**

What do we need to bring when going camping? Let's make a list and pack our imaginary (or not) backpack! Explore Canada's National parks through 360 virtual tours.

### **Camping Day**

#### Materials:

-Tent

Together with your child, set up a tent in the backyard/local park or the living room. If you do not have a tent, a makeshift one made with a tarp/blanket/sheet would also work.

Things to do in the tent when set up:

- Tell camping stories/ read more books
- Learn and sing camping songs
- Relax





#### S'mores

#### Materials:

- -Marshmallow
- -Graham crackers
- -Chocolate
- -Stovetop/Oven/Microwave/Air Fryer /Grill/Campfire

Together with the child, use whichever cooking method that is available to you to toast the marshmallows. Following a recipe helps your child learn to follow instructions, solve problems and make predictions and observations about cooking processes and their outcomes.
